Mild to Moderate Support Needs (MMSN) + MAT-SpEd

Preliminary credential to work with children and youth with disabilities who have mild to moderate support needs in kindergarten through age 22. Also offer Dual MMSN with Multiple Subject Credential.

Extensive Support Needs (ESN) + MAT-SpEd

Preliminary credential to work with children and youth with disabilities who have extensive support needs in kindergarten through age 22. Also offer Dual ESN with Multiple Subject Credential.

Early Childhood Special Education (ECSE) + MAT-SpEd (distance)

Preliminary credential to work with all children with disabilities birth to kindergarten and their families. Also offer ECSE-Added Authorization for current Education Specialists
