

## Expectations for a phased DJUSD Return to School and Connectivity

### Definitions:

**CONNECTIVITY FOR STUDENTS AT HOME:** Students have daily access to a working laptop or desktop computer AND dependable internet at home for instructional use and/or Distance Learning. This may be a shared device, or even a parent's desktop computer.

**DEPENDABLE INTERNET AT HOME:** Students have access to dependable internet in their home for instructional use and/or Distance Learning.

**1 to 1 Technology Initiative:** DJUSD expectation is that certain students have a dedicated Chromebook or laptop that is assigned to them for instructional use. This is their individual device and will travel with the student at all times, whether at home or on campus. The device may be an assigned DJUSD device or provided by the student from home, meeting these minimum specifications:

Chromebook: Minimum 4gb ram/memory and 16gb HDD/storage

Laptop: Minimum 8gb ram/memory and 500gb HDD/storage

**CONNECTIVITY OF STUDENTS AT SCHOOL:** For those students *not* assigned a personal device, they will have access to Chromebooks available at school that rotate among classrooms each day.

### Phase 1- Full Distance Learning:

This phase requires that every student in preschool to 12<sup>th</sup> grade is able to participate in virtual learning from home. All students will participate in online meetings, as well as use Canvas, the DJUSD Learning Management System.

- *CONNECTIVITY FOR STUDENTS AT HOME*
- *DEPENDABLE INTERNET AT HOME*

### Phases 3-5: Return to Campuses:

These phases will require all students in grades preschool to 12<sup>th</sup> grade to use Canvas, the DJUSD Learning Management System both at home and at school.

*These phases require:*

- CONNECTIVITY FOR STUDENTS AT HOME
- DEPENDABLE INTERNET AT HOME
- CONNECTIVITY FOR STUDENTS AT SCHOOL for grades preschool through 2<sup>nd</sup> grade
- 1 to 1 TECHNOLOGY for grades 3-12

Implementation of 1 to 1 Technology Initiative in Grades 3-12:

The implementation of 1 to 1 Technology Initiative for grades 3-12 will include identification of families wanting to provide/purchase their own device or check out a DJUSD Chromebook, assignment and distribution of these devices. This process will begin with options in Online Re-Enrollment, and will gradually take place in the first couple of months of school (during Distance Learning). Families wanting to check out a District Chromebook will be notified of this process.
